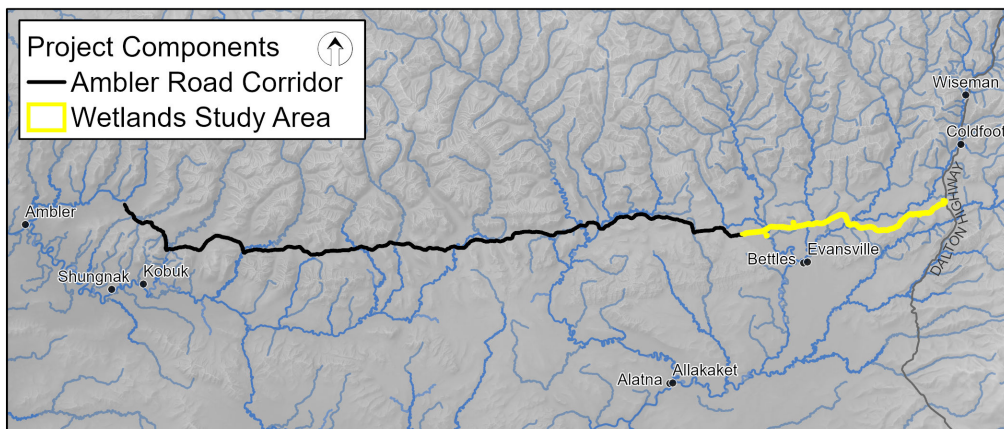
Ambler Access Project Public Notice: Wetlands Investigations

Schedule window: Between May 3 and October 3

What We're Doing:

The wetlands investigations will record the locations of wetland types, waters of the U.S. (stream, rivers, ponds, lakes), and invasive/sensitive plant species along the proposed road and at proposed road components. Wetland types will be determined by soil pits, vegetation surveys, and hydrological observations.

The surveys will be conducted on the easternmost 50 miles of the proposed corridor, which have not been field evaluated to date. The results of the field work will be used to create digital wetland and waters mapping that supports the engineering teams' ability to avoid and minimize impacts on wetlands and waters during Project design development.



WHAT?

Wetlands Investigations

WHEN?

Between May 3 and October 3 (USACE-established growing season)

WHERE?

The easternmost 50 miles of the proposed corridor.

WHY?

Map wetlands and waters along the corridor to avoid and minimize impacts when finalizing road design.

WHO?

2-3 scientists per crew
