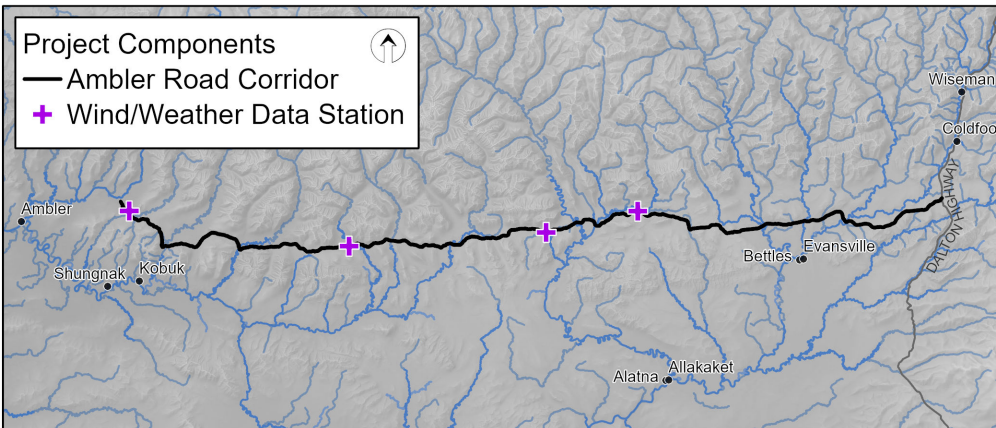
## Ambler Access Project

### Public Notice: Wind/Weather Data Stations

Schedule window: Spring - Fall

#### What We're Doing:

There will be wind and weather stations installed for one year. The data will be used by the aviation team to help determine the optimal placement and orientation of the four potential airfields, which will be located at proposed maintenance facilities along the alignment. The wind and weather sensors will be mounted on 10-meter lattice towers. The towers' foundations will be secured depending on the type of ground at the sites. For soft ground, rebar and duckbill stakes will secure the towers; at locations with rocky ground, threaded ground anchors will be utilized.
